

**A Resolution of the Haines Borough Assembly authorizing the Borough Manager to enter into a construction contract with Heger Stickler Construction for the Public Restroom Vinyl Replacement Project.**

**WHEREAS**, the Public Restroom Vinyl Replacement Project consists of removing fixtures and amenities, demolishing existing flooring, supplying and installing new flooring and re-installing fixtures and amenities in the Chilkat Center Lobby Restrooms and the Visitor Center Restrooms; and

**WHEREAS**, the Haines Borough (Borough) advertised a Request for Proposals (RFP) from qualified, licensed contractors to perform the work; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough received two proposals from qualified contractors in response to the RFP: **1) Heger Construction Company of Skagway for \$11,982 and 2) Stickler Construction Company for Haines, for \$11,998;** and

~~**WHEREAS**, the Director of Public Facilities reviewed the proposals and recommends the apparent low bidder; and~~

~~**WHEREAS**, Heger Construction Company is the apparent low bidder with a bid in the amount of \$11,982; and~~

**WHEREAS, HBC 3.60.160(A)(8) provides that preference may be given to the local bidder if the bid is up to three percent higher than that of the lowest bid; and**


**WHEREAS, a decision to award a contract to other than the bidder offering the lowest price shall be made only by the assembly, and it is the wish of the assembly to exercise that preference,**

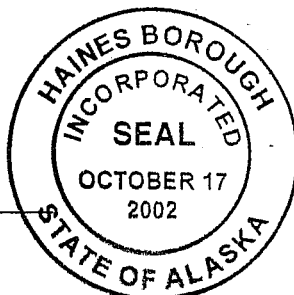
**WHEREAS**, this project will be funded by the Public Facilities maintenance budget, and available funds are sufficient for this project bid,


