A RESOLUTION OF THE HAINES BOROUGH ASSEMBLY DECLARING THE INTENTION TO CREATE BEAR CREEK TRAILS LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING MUNICIPAL WATER SERVICE INCLUDING FIRE HYDRANTS.

WHEREAS, property owners have petitioned the Borough to consider the creation of a Bear Creek Trails Local Improvement District (LID) for the purpose of providing municipal water service including fire hydrants; and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements would include installation of an extension of the water main, installation of required fire hydrants, resurfacing of the road after construction, and related work to make a complete improvement in accordance with Borough; and

WHEREAS, the petitioners represent a majority of those property owners who would collectively bear the costs of the improvements within the boundaries of the proposed LID; and

WHEREAS, the improvements would be paid for by means of a special assessment against the properties specially benefited by and included within the boundaries of the proposed LID; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Clerk, in consultation with the Borough Manager, has reviewed and finds the petition sufficient per HBC 3.90.040; and

WHEREAS, the assembly must determine by resolution whether the petition has sufficient and proper signatures, and whether the improvement is necessary; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the petition must be scheduled if the assembly finds the petition signatures and project necessity are in the affirmative; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Haines Borough Assembly:

- Section 1: That the petition contains sufficient and proper signatures.
- Section 2: That the project is necessary.
- Section 3: That the boundaries for the Bear Creek Trails LID are illustrated by the map attached as Exhibit A.
- Section 4: That a public hearing on the petition and the project's necessity is set for June 22, 2010.
