RESOLUTION No. 10-06-211

**Adopted**

**A Resolution of the Haines Borough Assembly authorizing the Borough Manager to enter into a professional services contract with Haines Animal Rescue Kennel to provide animal control services for an amount not to exceed \$47,344.**

**WHEREAS**, Haines Borough Code 6.08.060 requires that "[t]he manager shall appoint an animal control officer or firm whose duties shall be to enforce the provisions of this title. The borough shall provide an animal shelter where dogs may be impounded. In the absence of an animal control officer or firm contracted to enforce the animal control regulations, or if the assembly determines that additional personnel are necessary, the manager may appoint someone on a temporary basis to fulfill the animal control officer's duties."; and


**WHEREAS**, Haines Borough has contracted with Haines Animal Rescue Kennel (HARK) since 2003 and the current contract expires 6/30/10; and

**WHEREAS**, HARK has asked for an increase of \$6,844 which allows for one hour of pay per day for the animal control officer to be on standby for emergencies and also accounts for a 3% pay increase for the two workers employed by HARK; and


**WHEREAS**, funding for animal control services is budgeted annually and \$40,500 is currently in the adopted FY11 budget; the remaining \$6,844 will come in the near future as a budget amendment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Haines Borough Assembly authorizes the Borough Manager to enter into a professional services contract with Haines Animal Rescue Kennel to provide animal control services for an amount not to exceed \$47,344.
