**Adopted**

**A Resolution of the Haines Borough Assembly authorizing the Borough Manager to enter into a construction agreement with Dawson Construction, Inc. for the Mosquito Lake School Heating System Renovation project for an amount not to exceed \$201,550.**

**WHEREAS**, the Mosquito Lake School Heating System Renovation Project consists of demolition and disposal of existing boiler and associated equipment, replacement with two boilers, three heating coils, pumps, valves, controls and a concrete pad; and

**WHEREAS**, the Haines Borough (Borough) advertised a Invitation to Bid (ITB) from qualified, licensed contractors to perform the work; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough received one timely bid and one untimely bid from qualified contractors in response to the ITB; and


**WHEREAS**, the timely bid came from Dawson Construction, Inc. of Ketchikan, for \$201,550, and the untimely bid came from Schmolck Mechanical Contractors of Sitka, for \$202,294.75; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Public Facilities reviewed the proposals and recommends the responsive bidder, Dawson Construction, Inc. of Ketchikan, with a combined bid in the amount of \$201,550; and


**WHEREAS**, this project will be funded 65% by a grant from the Department of Education and Early Development secured by the Haines Borough School District (HBSD) and this grant requires a 35% local match which has been budgeted by HBSD, and available funds are sufficient for this project bid;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Haines Borough Assembly authorizes the Borough Manager to enter into a construction contract with Dawson Construction, Inc. for the Mosquito Lake School Heating System Renovation project for an amount not to exceed \$201,550.
