A RESOLUTION OF THE HAINES BOROUGH ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING
THE BOROUGH COORDINATED TRANSPORTATION PLAN 2008
REVISION

WHEREAS, public law 109-59, the **Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act - A Legacy for Users** (SAFETEA-LU), requires communities supported by state and federal human service transportation programs to adopt a coordinated human services transportation plan; and


WHEREAS, elderly and disabled residents benefit by the Care-A-Van program operated by Catholic Community Services, Inc. in the Haines Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Haines Borough Assembly on June 12, 2007 adopted Resolution 07-06-103 adopting the Haines Borough Coordinated Transportation Plan and continues to adhere to a process that includes representatives of public, private, and non-profit transportation and human services providers and the public in maintaining the plan and considering projects advanced by the plan; and

WHEREAS, the Haines Borough Transportation Task Force is recommending the Assembly's acceptance of the 2008 revision of the Haines Borough Coordinated Transportation Plan heard at public meeting on September 23, 2008;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Haines Borough Assembly hereby adopts the Haines Borough Coordinated Transportation Plan, 2008 Revision identifying support for the Care-A-Van program and other strategies that address transportation service needs and issues in the Haines Borough.
