A RESOLUTION OF THE HAINES BOROUGH ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING THE INCREASE OF CRUISE LINE TRAFFIC TO THE HAINES BOROUGH.

Whereas, the cruise ship industry is an important resource for the Haines community that has the ability to grow and be sustained; and

Whereas, with increasing fuel costs tourists coming over to Haines from vessels in Skagway may not continue to be viable; and

Whereas, tour businesses could not employ sufficient levels of staff to support the existing volume of Haines cruise ships without the traffic from Skagway, resulting in a reduction or elimination of cruise ship arrivals in Haines; and


Whereas, the Haines economy receives significant benefits from the cruise ship traffic which in turn supports our community and residents; and


Whereas, the Port Chilkoot Dock is under-utilized;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Haines Borough Assembly does hereby proclaim and resolve their support for the effort to increase the volume of cruise ship visitation.
