WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly is the governing body of the Haines Borough; and


WHEREAS, the Haines Borough has a desire to preserve historical and traditional features within the Borough, and

WHEREAS, achieving placement of this trail onto the National Register will benefit the Haines Borough by establishing eligibility to apply for funds for re-establishment of the historic trail and subsequent maintenance.
